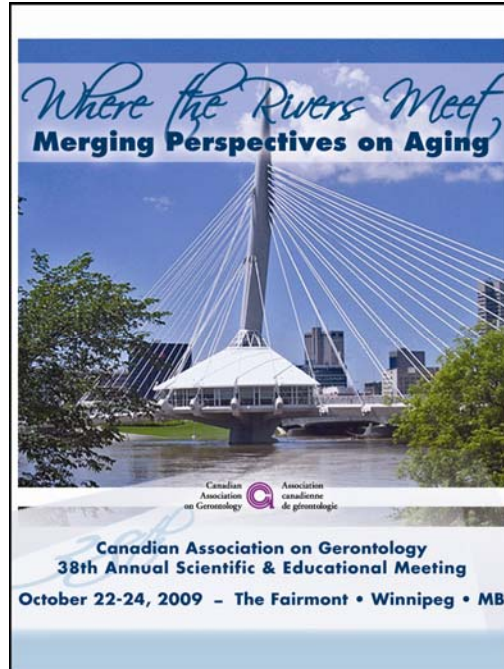


*“Where the Rivers Meet:
